NOTIFICATION

In accordance with Resolution no. AUK/AC-22/2024-02/04 of the Academic council meeting held on December 21, 2024, and the subsequent approval of the Board of Management vide Resolution No. BOM-24/2025/06 in its meeting on January 28, 2025, operational framework of Prakriti Club (Nature Club) for the students of College of Horticulture & Forestry, Jhalawar is hereby notified as under:-

Preamble

To propagate environment awareness, practical solutions and delivering responsibilities by students through informal collective approaches

Justification

Due to various anthropogenic activities—such as pollution, deforestation, and water scarcity, the environment is under the curse of irreparable damage. If immediate action is not taken to protect and restore nature, it will have detrimental, devastating effects on our wellbeing. The protection of our environment must be a top priority. In this context, it is hereby proposed to have a Nature Club at College of Horticulture and Forestry, Jhalawar that works under the collective responsibility of student's community to get engage in understanding, action oriented and service-oriented team work towards nature of their immediate surroundings. It will establish to raise awareness among students about pressing environmental issues and to foster a deeper connection with the natural world. In addition, it will encourage students to appreciate and protect Mother Nature by emphasizing the importance of conserving the planet's resources. Thus, the Nature Club is a dedicated programme aimed at educating students, faculty, and staff about environmental issues and sustainability. It will promote, monitor, and facilitate environmentally sustainable activities, beginning on the college campus and expanding to the wider community.

Objectives

- ❖ Inculcating interest, responsibility and service towards Nature and natural resources by the students through informal group activities.
- ❖ Catalysing the students to the local environmental problems and solutions through action oriented approaches.
- ❖ Realizing the students to involve and to sense their collective responsibility in attending and solving the local environmental issues.

Coordination Committee

Overall, the Dean shall be the Patron of the committee. Student functionaries besides students shall be member of coordinating committee. The details of the functionaries is follows

The tenure of the students representative of the committee shall be one academic year. However, all the students of B.Sc. (Hons.) Horticulture and B.Sc. (Hons.) Forestry of the college will be the member of Nature Club.

Proposed Activities

All kinds of informal, extension based environmental related educational, awareness and action oriented activities. Like, Seminars, Discussions, Screening films competitions, Quiz. Tree planting drives, celebration of vital Environment, Forest and Wildlife related special days or events. Visits to forest, conducting nature and biodiversity camps. Biodiversity Documentation, Photography. Organizing rallies, *jathas* and other cultural programs and practices.

Monitoring and evaluation

The activities of the Nature club are intended to stimulate the awareness, involvement and service of students towards their immediate surroundings. Hence, this non academic informal activity will be directly monitored and evaluated by the designated coordinator.

The Nature club activities should be financially supported from Boys Fund.
