



COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURE, UMMEDGANJ-KOTA

(Agriculture University, Kota)

About the College

The College of Agriculture, Kota has been established in April, 2018 as per budget announcement of Govt. of Rajasthan under the aegis of Agriculture University, Kota. This is second constituent college of this University and situated at Agricultural Research Station, Ummadganj, on Kota - Kaithoon main road 10 km away from bus stand and 15 km from city Railway station Kota. Teaching programme will be started from July, 2018. In the first year, this college is offering B.Sc. (Hon.) Agriculture with intake capacity of 60 seats (45 normal and 15 payments seats), M.Sc. (Ag.) in discipline of Agronomy (5 seats), Genetics & Plant breeding (5 seats), Plant Pathology (4 seats), Soil Science & Agri. Chemistry (4 seats), Entomology (4 seats) and Horticulture (4 seats) including 01 payment seat in each discipline. This college is also offering Ph.D. program in Agronomy and Genetics & Plant Breeding with intake of 2 seats in each. The frequent Mini and City buses are available from Aerodrum circle Kota to reach this college.



Facilities available:

- 1. Well developed instructional farm:** Agriculture Research Station, Ummadganj, Kota where college is established, is having well developed and bounded instructional farm spread over an area of 115 ha. This farm is situated near the Right Main Canal of Chambal dam, hence suffice the irrigation requirement.
- 2. Faculty position:** 37 teachers are working as per detailed below:

Besides, 07 faculty of different disciplines is also available in KVK, Kota whose services will also utilized. Other required faculty (about 20) will also be recruited by end of August, 2018. The teaching staff strength is fully supported by non-teaching and supporting staff for assisting in office, lab. and farm work.

- 3. Class rooms:** Required class rooms for UG and PG students are available which are also being modified and renovated.
- 4. Library:** Well furnished library, including internet facilities is available at this college. Approximate 1100 printed books, 200 e-books of various subjects are available. Approximate 150 printed journals and 30 e-journals are subscribed by this college for the students visiting the library. Recently some more books costing Rs. 4.00 lakhs upto Ph.D. level have also been added.
- 5. Hostel facilities:** College will provide hostel facilities to girl students which is under renovation and available by end of July. For boy students, sufficient private rooms and accommodations are available in nearby area including Kaithoon, Dhakarkheri and Kota. However, during 2019, they may also be provided hostel facilities.
- 6. Sports and games facilities:** Sports and games facilities such as *kabaddi*, *volleyball*, *basketball*, table tennis and other facilities will be created very soon for recreation of the students for which budget have been earmarked.
- 7. Laboratory facilities:** Well equipped and functional labs are available in department of Agronomy, PBG, Soil Science, Plant Pathology, Horticulture, Entomology, Biochemistry & Physiology. Important equipments available are Spectrophotometer, AAS, HPLC, GC, EC, PH meter, microscopes, laminar flow, nitrogen, phosphorus, nutrient determination facilities etc. with other required facilities. Some more equipments have also been added recently as per requirement. The laboratories are being renovated and modified as per need.
